

20 INSIGHTS FOR 2020 ABOUT STUDENTS, TECH, AND SOCIAL MEDIA

Social media is simply how students socialize. Yet students are taught that social platforms are only dangerous and adults lecture students on the Don'ts, not the Do's. This report helps pinpoint opportunities for schools to reimagine social media education.

These findings represent a nationwide survey of 13,874 students and 1,265 parents at independent and public schools, conducted Aug. 1 - Dec. 31, 2019.


